

The Late Thomas Getz.

Thomas Getz, who died on Saturday at his late home in Dunnstable township, was buried yesterday. The services were held in the Zeigler church, near Chatham's Run, at ten o'clock in the forenoon. Interment in the cemetery near the church. Deceased was a man in his 68th year and enjoyed the friendship of a large circle. He was known as one of the solid, sturdy farmers of Dunnstable township, and his demise will be felt not only by his blood connections but by his neighbors.
